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All that piece, parcel or tract of land located in Berkeley County near the intersection of Interstate Highway Number 26 and U. S. Alternate Number 27, East of the Town of Summerville and near the intersection of said highways, said property being denominated as Parcel A and containing 9.38 acres as shown on a plat prepared for Hunt Development Company by B. P. Barber & Associates, Inc., Engineers, V. F. Walker, Jr., Registered Professional Engineer, Number 1066, and Land Surveyor, said plat being dated August 31, 1976, and being plat number 17598-Gll, said property being more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point where a frontage road leading to U. S.
