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cause of action and/or chose in action.

14. This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal, which renders the principal incapable of managing her own estate. I direct that my attorney be permitted to serve without bond and that she not be required to file any inventory of all deposits, choses in action and personal property.

I do hereby ratify and confirm all things whatsoever my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents, including anything which shall be done between the revocation of these presents by my death, or in any other manner, and notice of such revocation reaching my attorney; and I hereby declare that as against me and all persons claiming under me, everything which my attorney shall do, or cause to be done, after such revocation as aforesaid, shall be valid and effective in favor of any person claiming the benefit thereof, who, before the doing thereof shall not have had notice of such revocation.
