POWER OF ATTORNEY

- (2) To sign checks withdrawing or transferring funds from any bank in which money may be deposited in my name, to accept, collect and endorse any checks, including Social Security checks, drafts or instruments for the payment of money.
- (3) To borrow money and execute notes or other instruments securing the repayment thereof and to pledge as security therefore any stocks, bonds, securities or property which I may own and/or to mortgage any real or personal property which I may own, in order to secure said loans.
- (4) To ask, demand, sue for, recover, collect and receive all such sums of money, debts, accounts, interest, dividends, annuities and all demands whatsoever as now are, or hereafter shall, become due, owing or payable to me.
- (5) To make, execute and deliver acquittances, receipts, releases or other discharges therefore.
- (6) To be my lawful proxy and to vote any stocks and security I may own or hereafter acquire and to exercise all
