SMITH, of Fulton County, Georgia, my true and lawful attorney in fact, for me, and in my name, place and stead, giving and granting unto said attorney in fact full and complete power and authority concerning any part and all my property of record or any vested interest I may possess in real property situated in GREENVILLE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA and in WORTH COUNTY, GEORGIA to manage, rent, collect rentals, subdivide and sell, collect the purchase money, and make warranty deeds, under seal, and to do generally and perform all and every act or acts whatsoever needful and necessary to be done for me and in my name, to do, execute and perform as largely and amply to all intents and purposes as I, myself, could do if I were personally present, and by these presents I hereby ratify and confirm all that said attorney in fact shall do by virtue hereof.

This power of attorney shall remain effective until revoked.
