N. N. N. page 492 Reference being thereunto had may mercifully appear) and also all Lanes, Traces, Woods, Underwoods, Tithes, Commons, Common of Pasture, Profits Commodities, Advantages, Hereditaments, Ways, Waters, and Appurtenances whatsoever to the said mesuage or Tenements and premises above mentioned belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also the Reversion and Reversions, Remainders and Remainders, Rents and Services of the said premises, and of every Part thereof: and also all the Estate, Right, Title, Interest Claim and demand, whatsoever of him the said Hulet Swevelent of in and to the said plantation or tract of Land, computed one hundred and Eighty acres (be the same more or less) and of every part thereof: To have and to hold the said Tract of one hundred and Eighty acres of Land, and all and singular the premises above mentioned, with every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances, unto the said William Story, his heirs and assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Story his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Hulet Swevelent, for himself and his heirs the said tract of one hundred and Eighty acres by computation (be the same more or less) with the appurtenances, and every part thereof: against them and their heirs and against all and every other person or persons, whatsoever, to the said William Story his heirs and assigns, shall and will warrant, and forever defend by these presents, In Witness whereof the said Hulet Swevelent hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year first above written

Carolina, to Cumberland River in the State of North Carolina (and for other good Causes, and Considerations, me hereunto moving) having made, Ordained, and constituted, and appointed, and by these presents (for me my Executors administrators and Every of them) do make, ordain, constitute, and appoint, my trusty and well beloved friend Baylis Earle, of the State of South Carolina aforesaid, in the County of Spartanburgh Gent. my true and lawfull Attorney, for me, and in my name to make over, convey, & confirm, unto Esly Hunt, (of the State and County last mentioned) a certain Tract or parcel of Land, Situate on Saluda River, in the County aforesaid, about a mile below the mouth of the N. fork of said River and surveyed by William Benson Esq. for me the said Hugh Lewis and said to contain one hundred acres, be the same more or less, and I do hereby grant unto my said Attorney, my sole and full power, & authority to take, pursue, and follow such legal Courses, for confirming the Right of the Land aforesaid, unto the said Esly Hunt, as I myself might or could do, were I personally present, Ratifying, allowing, and confirming whatsoever my said Attorney shall lawfully do, or cause to be done, in, and about the Execution of the premises, by Virtue of these presents, In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 3 day of October, in the tenth year of the Independence of America, and in the year of our Lord 1705
