

This Indenture made this Eighteenth day of November one Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Eight Between Isom Clayton of Greenville County and State of South Carolina of the one part and John Meathers of the same county and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Isom Clayton for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds to him in hand paid by the said John Meathers the receipt whereof the said Isom Clayton doth hereby Acknowledge that he the said Isom Clayton hath granted bargained and sold alien and Confirm and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien and Confirm unto the said John Meathers his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred acres situate in Ninety Six District on the branches of Saluda River bounding all sides on vacant land at the time when first surveyed. Granted to the said Isom Clayton by his Excellency Benjamin Guillard Esquire on the twenty first day of January 1785. Beginning on a red oak thence 20° W to one fork of Bushs Creek thence up the said Creek to the mouth of the said John Meathers Spring branch thence up the said branch to a red oak thence a line agreed upon to the said Clayton line thence from the said line to a corner Stake thence to the Beginning containing one hundred acres be the same more or less and Trees woods & the Common Commissions of pastures profits Commodities advantages hereditaments ways waters and appurtenances whatsoever to the said mesuage or tenement and premises above mentioned belonging or in any ways appertaining and also the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rents and Services of the said premises and every part thereof and all the Estate right Title Interest Claim and Demand whatsoever of him the said Isom Clayton in and to the said mesuage Tenement and premises and every part thereof To have and to hold the said mesuage or Tenement and all and singular the premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said John Meathers his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said John Meathers his heirs and assigns forever and to the said John Meathers for him and his heirs the said tract of one

hundred acres of land (be the same more or less) and every part thereof against him and his heirs and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever to the said John Meathers his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said Isom Clayton hath hereunto set his hand and Seal the day and date above written

South Carolina & Columbia the Seventeenth one Thousand Seven Greenville County & hundred and Eighty Eight. A Deed of conveyance for one hundred acres of land from Abraham Hudson to Lunceford Hudson. Proved in open court by the oath of Pearson Hudson and Howard Finley and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this Eighteenth of February in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Eight, and in the twelfth year of the Independence of the united State of America. Between Abraham Hudson of Greenville County and State of South Carolina of the one part, and Lunceford Hudson of the said county and State of the other part Witnesseth for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds Sterling Lawful money in hand paid by Lunceford Hudson. hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain sell and make over unto the said Lunceford Hudson a certain plantation or tract of land containing one hundred acres situate Lyins and being in said Greenville county on South fork of Rocky Creek of Enoree River. whereas it is part of the part that said Lunceford Hudson is now possessed of, said Abraham Hudson land he hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain sell and convey unto the Lunceford Hudson the above described tract of land Together with the woods waters Hereditaments and appurtenances unto said land belonging or in any wise appertaining and reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rents Issues and profits thereof To have and to hold the granted premises of the above mentioned tract of one hundred acres of land unto the said Lunceford Hudson his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns forever and that the said Abraham Hudson his heirs Executors Administrators &c. doth Covenant and agree to and with the said Lunceford Hudson
