

South Carolina Greenville County November the Nineteenth one Thou-
sand Seven hundred and Eighty Eight. A deed of conveyance for two hun-
dred acres of land from Thomas Farrar to Edmund Peters, provide by the oath
of James Yancey Junr in open court and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this twentieth day of September in the
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Eight, and the
thirteenth year of the Independence of the united States of America between
Thomas Farrar of Spartanburg County and State aforesaid of the one part,
and Edmund Peters of Greenville County and State aforesaid of the other
part, Whereas by a certain Grant bearing date the 15th day of October Anno
Domini one thousand seven hundred and Eighty four and in the ninth
year of the Independence of the united States of America, from under the hand
of his Excellency, Benjamin Gueraud Esquire Governor and Commis-
sioner in chief in and over the said state, having the great seal of the state
thereunto affixed, being for that purpose appointed and give and grant
unto the said Thomas Farrar a plantation or tract of land containing two
hundred acres lying and being in the County aforesaid on the Beaver
Dam Creek of Enoree River above the ancient boundary line, and
with such shape and marks, buttings and boundings as appears by a
plat annexed, which said plat and grant being recorded in the Secretarys
Office grant book B. B. B. page 30 Reference thereto being had may
more fully appear. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said
Thomas Farrar for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds
current money of said state to him in hand well and truly paid by
the said Edmund Peters before the sealing and Delivering of these presents
the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath given, granted, bargain
and sold and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain sell and con-
vey unto the Edmund Peters the above described tract of land, together
with the woods waters Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
land belonging or in anywise appertaining, and Reversion and
Reversions, Remainder and Remainders, Rents, Issues and profits thereof
To have and to hold the Granted premises of and belonging to the
said tract of land unto the said Edmund Peters his heirs Executors

Administrators and assigns forever, and that the said Thomas Farrar his heirs
Executors Administrators &c doth Covenant and agree to and with the said
Edmund Peters his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns, shall at all
times hereafter peaceably and quietly occupy possess and Enjoy the aforesaid
Tract of land, lying and being as aforesaid, from all former bargains, Sales
Mortgages, Judgments, Rights, Dowaries &c. and from all other Incumbrances
whatsoever and that the said Thomas Farrar his heirs Executors Administrators
and assigns forever shall and will warrant and forever defend the afore-
said tract of land unto the said Edmund Peters his heirs Executors Administra-
tors and assigns forever from all and every other person or persons that may
lay any claim or title thereunto In witness whereof the said Thomas Far-
rar hath herunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above
written.

South Carolina Greenville County November the Nineteenth one Thou-
sand Seven hundred and Eighty Eight. A Deed of Conveyance for one hundred
and sixty six ^{acres of land} from Isaac Robison to Edwin Smith (being previously proved
before a magistrate) was ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made the fourteenth day of September in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven between Isaac
Robison of the State of South Carolina and Ninety six district of the one part, &
Edwin Smith of the State aforesaid of the other part, Noted with that for and in
consideration of the sum of sixty pounds Sterling to him the said Isaac Robison
well and truly paid the Receipt whereof the said Isaac Robison doth hereby ac-
knowledge, hath granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth
grant bargain sell and Deliver unto the said Edwin Smith in his actual
possession by virtue of a bargain and sale to him made by the said Isaac
Robison a certain Tract of land containing one hundred and sixty six
acres situate in Greenville County on Saluda River butting and bounding
on all sides by vacant land at the time it was laid out and hath such
shape and marks natural and artificial as a plat thereof herunto annex-
ed doth Represent, together with all and singular the ways waters water-
courses minerals and every appurtenance thereunto belonging. To
have and to hold the said plantation or tract of land containing one
hundred and sixty six acres and all and singular the premises hereby
granted and Reversed unto the said Edwin Smith his heirs Executors
Administrators and assigns forever, and the said Isaac Robison for
himself his heirs and assigns doth covenant and agree with the said
Edwin Smith his heirs and assigns by these presents in manner and
form following that is to say that the said Smith shall have an ab-
