


 acres of land from John Haven to William Brown, proved by the oath of George  
 Ruffel in open court and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this nineteenth day of January in the year of our Lord  
 One thousand seven hundred and eighty nine and in the thirtieth year of American  
 Independence Between John Haven of Greenville County and State of S. Carolina  
 of the one part, and William Brown of the County and State aforesaid of the other  
 part Whereas by a certain grant, bearing date the first day of January A.D. One thou-  
 sand seven hundred and eighty seven from under the hand of his Excellency William
