South Carolina Greenville County February the Seventeenth One Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Nine, Release for Six hundred and forty acres of land from John Milling to Alexander Padden, (being proved before a magistrate) and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made the Eighth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and Eighty Seven, and in the Eleventh year of the States U.C. Between John Milling of Fairfield County, State of South Carolina of the one part and Alexander Padden of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said John Milling for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Shillings old currency of South Carolina to him in hand well and truly to be paid by the said Alexander Padden at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that the said John Milling hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Alexander Padden all that plantation or tract of six hundred and forty acres of land being and lying in Ninety six district on the branches of Peedy River Together with all and singular the Houses outhouses Edifices buildings Barns Stables yards Gardens Orchards Woods underwoods Timber and timber-trees Meadows Pastures Ponds Lakes Fishings ways water and water courses Paths Passages Liberties, Priviledges Profits Hereditaments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversion or reversions, remainder and remainders rents Issues and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said plantation or tract of six hundred and forty acres of land with every the premises and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said Alexander Padden his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns from the day next before the day of the date of these presents for and during and untill the full end and term of one whole year from thence next ensuing and fully to be completed and ended Yielding And Paying thereof unto the said John Milling the rent of one paper corn on the last day of the said term if the same be required lawfully to the intent and purpose that by virtue of these presents and by force of the Statute for transferring of uses into possession he the said Alexander Padden may be in actual Possession of all and singular above mention: ed with every the appurtenances thereunto belonging and thereby be the better Enabled to have take and receive the reversion and Inheritance thereof which is Intended to be to him and his granted and released by the said John Milling by another Indenture Intended to be made and dated the day next to the day of the date hereof In Witness whereof the said parties to these presents have here: unto set their hand and Seal the day and year first above written.
