61 This Indenture made the twenty fifth day of April in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty nine, between Henry Domery of Orangeburgh District planter of the one part and John Alexander of Greenville County and District of Ninety six planter of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Henry Domery for and in consideration of the sum of ten ~~hundred~~ Shillings Sterling money to him in hand paid, hath bargained sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said John Alexander his heirs Executors and Administrators all that plantation or tract of land containing six hundred and forty acres situate in Ninety six District on the waters of Peedy River bounding on the North West on lands laid out to Thomas Jenkins and all other sides on vacant and hath such shape form and marks as appears by a plat to the original grant annexed. Together with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversion or reversions remainder and remainders thereof To have and to hold the said plantation or tract of land containing six hundred and forty acres hereby granted and sold or intended to be hereby bargained and sold unto the said John Alexander his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns from the day of the date hereafter and during the term of one whole year from thence next ensuing fully to be compleated and ended yielding and paying therefore the rent of one peppor corn to the said Henry Domery on the last day of the said term if the same shall lawfully be demanded to the intent and purpose the said Henry Domery by virtue hereof and by force of the Statute for transferring uses into possession may be in actual possession of the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be hereby bargained and sold and hereby enabled to accept and take a grant and release of the reversion and inheritance of the same to him and his heirs for ever In Witness whereof the said Henry Domery hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and date first above written.
