

hundred and Eighty nine, A Deed of Gift from Andrew Nelson to Andrew Nel-  
son Junr and Thomas Nelson, acknowledged in open court and ordered to be re-  
corded.

Know all men by these presents that I Andrew Nelson of Greenville County and  
State of South Carolina planter for divers good considerations therunto memo-  
ring hath by virtue of these presents freely given into the actual possession  
of my two beloved sons Andrew Nelson and Thomas Nelson all my whole  
estate real and personal (viz) unto Andrew Nelson one Horse one mare and  
one colt three cows and three calves four Steers and three Heifers together with  
all my farming utensils: and unto Thomas Nelson three cows and their calves  
three Steers and two Heifers, one mare and colt, and a tract of land which I  
now doth live upon lying and being on both sides of Reedy River consisting  
of two hundred acres together with all my other goods and Chattels to be equal-  
ly divided between these my two sons Andrew and Thomas Nelson and to  
them and their heirs for ever. In Witness whereof I hath hereunto set my  
hand and affixed my seal this Eighth day of April in the year of One Thousand  
seven hundred and Eighty nine.

hundred and Eighty nine, A lease and release for one hundred and forty acres of  
land from Henry Linderman to John Linderman, acknowledged in open  
court by the said Henry Linderman and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made the fourteenth day of August One Thousand Seven  
Hundred and Eighty nine, and in the fourteenth year of the Independence of  
America between Henry Linderman of Greenville County and State of  
South Carolina weaver of the one part, and John Linderman of the County  
and State aforesaid planter of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said Henry  
Linderman for and in consideration of the sum of forty pounds Sterling to him  
in hand paid by the said John Linderman at and before the sealing and deli-  
very of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said  
Henry Linderman hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain  
and sell unto the said John Linderman a tract of land containing one hun-  
dred and forty acres being part of a tract of six hundred and forty acres original-  
ly granted to James McWilliams by His Excellency Benjamin Guerard Esq  
Governor and commander in chief in and over the said State and the great seal  
of the said State for that purpose appointed bearing date the twenty first day of  
January one thousand seven hundred and eighty five Situate lying and being  
on Reedy River above the antient boundary line, the said tract of one hundred  
and forty acres being sold and conveyed by the said James McWilliams unto the said  
Henry Linderman by lease and release, bounded North East by the said Reedy  
River, South East by a part of the said tract laid out to Matthew Armstrong South  
West by land granted to Honce Black, North West by land granted to said James  
McWilliams, including one hundred and forty acres more or less, Together with  
all and singular the Houses outhouses Edifices, buildings, barns, stables, yards,  
gardens, Orchards, trees, woods, underwoods, fishings, ways, waters and water courses
