

South Carolina Greenville County August the seventeenth One thousand Seven hundred and eighty nine, A Deed of Conveyance for one hundred and ten acres of land from William Gough to ~~James~~ ^{William} Stringer, produced in open court, being proved before John Ford Esquire, and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this fourth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and eighty nine, and the thirteenth year of American Independence between William Gough of the one part and William Stringer of the other part, both of the State of South Carolina Ninety Six district Met: witness that the said William Gough for and in consideration of the sum of Forty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by William Stringer before sealing and delivering of these presents that the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged hath given granted and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell alien and release convey and confirm unto the said William Stringer and to his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the State aforesaid and in Greenville County on both sides of the ~~the~~ South fork of the Beaver dam Creek Chechoe, cutting & bounding as follows beginning at Beaver dam Creek Black Gum 313 Spanish Oak 3x Chestnut 3 Vacant land, to Chestnut 3 Pine 3 Poplar 3 Post oak 3x Vacant land to Sweet Gum Poplar 3x N 59 E 79. 40 Pine 3x White oak Pine, N 70 10 28 black Gum on to the first Station containing by Estimation One hundred and ten acres, situate in the district of Ninety Six, on the South fork of the Beaver dam Creek of the Chechoe and hath such form and marks cuttings and boundings as the above plat represents Certified for the 22 day of January 1785 Set Gen as by reference therunto had may more fully and at large appear Together with all the woods ways water water courses buildings improvements and appurtenances whatsoever unto the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversions and remainders rents issues and profits thereof unto the said William Stringer and his heirs and his heirs and assigns forever free and clear from all forms Sales, Mortgages, Judgments, executions dowers and rights of dowers peaceably and quietly to possess and enjoy the aforesaid tract of land being now in possession of the said William Stringer Subject nevertheless to such rents dues and profits as shall hereafter become due and payable unto the chief Lord or Lords of the fee To have and to hold the said bargained premises of one hundred ten acres above described unto the proper use and behoof of him the said William Stringer his heirs and assigns for ever and that the said William Gough his heirs Executors administrators shall and will warrant and by these presents for ever defend the above described tract or parcel of land unto the said William Stringer his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns from all and every other person or persons whatsoever laying any lawful claim therunto.
