

State and County aforesaid of the other part, witnesseth that the said Robert Hazlip for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy pounds, to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and him the said Robert Hazlip hath given granted bargained sold aliened geffed released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien geff release and confirm unto the said Mary Hall his heirs assigns one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the district of Ninety Six N^E side of Saluda and on the said River in the State and County aforesaid containing two hundred and Seventy nine acres of land granted to the said Robert Hazlip by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney Governor of the State of South Carolina granted and dated the Seventh day of April One thousand Seven hundred and eighty eight, lying and being as aforesaid; beginning at a W oak 3x0 and runs North 50 to a red oak & 22 40 to a Spanish oak 3x 880 to a black oak 0 30 E 9. 75 to a White oak 3x0 N. 070 to a red oak 0 30 E 28 to a post oak 3x South 30 E 18. 60 to a lake South 20 W 08. 50 to a red oak 3x 885 ft 7. 10 to a maple 3x on Saluda as will more fully appear by a plat thereunto annexed to the aforesaid grant and record in Secretary's office of said State reference being had thereto will more fully and at large appear. Together with all Houses gardens orchards Edifices buildings woods underwoods timber and timber trees meadows ponds lakes ways waters and water courses paths passages priviledges profits hereditaments rights members and appurtenances thereto belonging & the reversions and reversions remainder and remainders rents and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof and all the estate right title profit claim and demand whatsoever unto the said Mary Hall his heirs and assigns for unto the only inheritance and legacy for him the said Mary Hall his heirs and assigns to have and to hold the said granted land and premises above mentioned from all former sales gifts grants mortgages rights of dower or any other incumbrances whatsoever and he the said Robert Hazlip for himself his heirs and assigns doth covenant and agree to and with the said Mary Hall his heirs and assigns that they and they shall and may at all times hereafter hold use occupy and possess the above granted lands and premises without the least hindrance or molestation of him the said Robert Hazlip his heirs Executors administrators and assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever claiming or to claim in by or under them or ~~any~~ either of them & further the said Robert Hazlip his heirs Executors administrators and assigns the said granted land and premises unto the said Mary Hall his heirs and assigns shall and will forever defend unto the said Mary Hall forever.
