

South Carolina Greenville County November the Twentieth One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty nine, A Deed of conveyance for two hundred acres of land from William Gilham to Thomas Jenkins proved in open court by the oath of John M. Elroy and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this ninth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty nine, Between William Gilham of Ninety Six district and State of South Carolina of the one part, and Thomas Jenkins of the said State and district of the other part, Witnesses, that the said William Gilham for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pound lawful money to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Thomas Jenkins at and before the Sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt thereof the said William Gilham both hereby acknowledge and thereby and of and from every part and parcel thereof do acquit and discharge the said Thomas Jenkins his heirs and assigns and for divers other good causes and considerations hereunto moving have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Thomas Jenkins his heirs and assigns forever all that ~~particular~~ parcel or tract of land lying and being in Greenville County on the branches of Reedy River containing two hundred acres originally granted unto William Gilham and signed by His Excellency William Moultrie on the fourth day of December One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Six as by a plat annexed to the said grant will more fully appear Together with all and singular the Houses outhouses ways waters paths passages trees fences easements hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of land so described as above belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof and all the estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever both in law and equity of the said William Gilham of in and to the same premises and of in and to every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said parcel or tract of land and all and singular other the premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the said Thomas Jenkins his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Thomas Jenkins his heirs and assigns forever. And Lastly the said William Gilham for himself and his heirs the said tract of land and all and singular the premises above granted with their appurtenances unto the said Thomas Jenkins and his heirs against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and for defend In Witnesses whereof the said William Gilham doth hereunto set his hand and seal this day and year first above written.
