whosoever to the said Richard Brazzle his heirs and assigns shall and with  
warrant and for ever defend by these presents In Witnesses whereof the said



As a Court began and held February Term 1790 the following deed of con-  
veyance from Thomas Revil unto Page Puckett was produced in court and  
acknowledged by the said Thomas Revil and ordered to be Recorded —

This Indenture made the fifteenth day of February in the year of our Lord  
one thousand seven hundred and Ninety and in the fourteenth year of Ame-  
-rican Independance between Thomas Revil of the State of South Carolina  
Laurence County Carpenter of the one part and Page Pucket of the said State  
and County of Greenville of the other part planter, - Whereas in and by a cer-  
-tain Grant bearing date the third day of March one thousand seven hun-  
-dred and eighty eight from under the hand of Thomas Pinckney then Esq<sup>r</sup>  
Governor and commander in chief in and over the said State and the great  
seal of the said State for that purpose appointed did give and Grant unto  
Thomas Revil a plantation or Tract of seven hundred and fifty Acres of  
land on Braskey Creek waters of Enoree River having such Shape form  
and marks as appears by a plat to the said Grant annexed as in and  
by the said plat and Grant duly Recorded in the secretary's Office in  
the said State in book WWWW Page 311 Reference thereunto had more  
fully appears; Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Thomas  
Revil for and in consideration of Two pounds six shillings and eight  
pence Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Page Pucket the Receipt  
of which is hereby acknowledged he the said Thomas Revil hath bargain-  
-ed and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell Release convey  
and confirm unto the said Page Pucket his heirs and assigns one hundred  
and fifty acres being part of said Tract of seven hundred and fifty acres  
Running S 50<sup>th</sup> 42-50 to a corner pine thence S 30<sup>th</sup> 40 to a station White  
Oak thence continuing on said line till a Strait line across to Singa-  
-mon Whortons line shall include one hundred and fifty acres —
