153 At a Court began and held for February Term 1798 the following Deed  
 of Conveyance from Daniel Kelley to Henry Allwood was produced in open Court  
 and Acknowledged by said Daniel Kelley and Ordered to be Recorded

This Indenture made the thirteenth day of February in the year of our  
 Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight in the 27th year of the  
 Independance of the united States of America between Daniel Kelley  
 and Sarah his wife of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville  
 of the first part and Henry Allwood of the County of Spartanburgh and  
 State aforesaid of the Other part Witnesses that the said Daniel Kelley  
 and Sarah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds  
 Sterling money to them in hand paid at and before the making and deliv-  
 ering of these presents, the Receipt and payment whereof is hereby Acknow-  
 ledged, and the said Daniel Kelley and Sarah his wife doth hereby Acknow-  
 ledge themselves fully satisfied & paid have given Granted bargained &  
 sold and by these presents doth give Grant bargain sell Alien Enfeoffed  
 convey and confirm unto the said Henry Allwood a certain Tract or parcel  
 of land, situate lying and being in the County of Greenville & State of  
 South Carolina Originally granted to Joseph Dunn and Transferred by  
 him to Daniel Kelley being part of the aforesaid Tract Granted to the  
 said Dunn and bearing date the Twenty first day of January one thousand  
 seven hundred and eighty five bounding as follows beginning on the North side  
 Chacheroa River Running thence S. 25 E. to a Red Oak Corner thence S 35 W 24  
 to a Hickory corner thence N 76 E 48 to a M.D. thence N 14 W 25 to a Stake  
 thence S 70 W 26 to a R.C. on said River thence with the meanders of the said
