164 The following deed of conveyance from Robert Prince to Johnson Monroe was proven before George Salmon Esquire by the oath of John Baylis Park and ordered to be Recorded

This Indenture made the nineteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine between Robert Prince of Greenville County in the state of South Carolina of the one part, and Johnson Monroe of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five Shillings Sterling in hand paid to the said Robert Prince by the said Monroe before the signing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the aforesaid Robert Prince hath hereby bargained sold and conveyed unto the above mentioned Johnson Monroe one hundred Acres of Land more or less Bounding and bordering as follows Viz Beginning at a Red Oak thence S<sup>o</sup> 10 W 12 Chain 20 link to a post Oak thence S<sup>o</sup> 15 E<sup>o</sup> 53 chain to a black Oak, thence N<sup>o</sup> 72 E 16 chain to a pine, thence N<sup>o</sup> 57 W 43 chain Post Oak, from thence to the beginning; It being part of a tract of land of four thousand acres granted to Robert Prince the seventh of March one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven; Together with all woods waters profits commodities heridaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining To have & to hold the said tract of Land hereby granted and to sole with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Johnson Monroe his heirs and assigns for ever and the said Robert Prince for himself his Heirs Exe<sup>r</sup> Adm<sup>t</sup> and assigns the said hereby bargained premises with their appurtenances unto the said Monroe his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims of every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said Robert Prince hath hereunto set his hand and Seal the day and year first above written.
