This Indenture made this fourth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety between John Lafferty of Ninety six district and state of South Carolina of the one part, and Solomon Murphy Maginis of the said state and district of the other Part Witnesseth that the said John Lafferty for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling money to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Solomon Murphy Maginis at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt thereof the said John Lafferty doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and of and from every part and parcel thereof to acquit and discharge the said Solomon Murphy Maginis his heirs and assigns and for divers other good causes and considerations hereunto moving have granted bargained sold Alien in feoff and confirm unto the said Solomon Murphy Maginis his heirs and assigns for ever, all that parcel or Tract of land lying and being in Greenville County on Lafferty's branch containing one hundred acres bounded on John Smiths land on the south and North by Robert Ramseys his land, it being part of a Tract of one thousand acres of land Originally granted unto John
