


Interest claim and demand whatsoever of him the said William Story

The following deed of conveyance from Gersham Welley to John Sims was
 produced in Open Court May Term 1790 and acknowledged by the S.
 Gersham Welley and Ordered to be Recorded. — Recorded this 4th
 day of June 1790.

State of South Carolina. This Indenture made
 this eighteenth day of May one thousand seven hundred and ninety between
 Gersham Welley of the State aforesaid and Greenville County of the one part
 and John Sims of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that
 the said Gersham Welley for and in consideration of the sum of eighty
 pounds lawful Sterling money to him in hand well and fully made
 by the said John Sims at and before the sealing and delivery of these
 presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have Granted
 bargained sold aliened Released and Confirmed and by these pre-
 sents do Grant bargain sell, alien Release and confirm unto the said
 John Sims him his heirs and assigns for ever all that Part of a certain
 Tract of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Greenville
 and on the south Side of Ready River bounded on the North by Ready
 River and North West by Ready Fork of Ready River including one
 half of the mill Shoal on said Ready Fork extending to the middle
 of the Ready Fork from the confluence of Ready River as far up as the
 said Shoal extends and Originally Granted unto John Winn Junr.
 and Signed by his Excellency Benjamin Guerard on the sixteenth day
 of July one thousand seven hundred and eighty Four as by a plot an-
 nexed to said Grant will more fully appear Together with all and
