The following deed of Conveyance from Robert Ramsey and Elisabeth Ramsey to Andrew Lafferty was produced in Open Court and proven by the Oath of Hugh Roark & William Bonds & Ordered to be recorded - Recorded this 8th day of November 1790.

This Indenture made this Twentysixth day of July in the year four Lord one thousand Seven hundred and ninety between Robert Ramsey of the district of Ninety six and State of South of the one part & Andrew Lafferty of the said State and District of the other part Witnesseth that the said Robert Ramsey for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty Pounds Lawfull Sterling money to him in hand paid by the said Andrew Lafferty at and before the sealing and delivring of these presents the Receipt hereof the said Robert Ramsey doth hereby acknowledge and thereof & from every part and parcel thereof do acquit and acknowledge the said Andrew Lafferty his heirs and assigns for ever all that Parcel or Tract of Land Lying and being in Greenville County and on a branch of Needy River containing ~~one hundred~~ one hundred and Sixty Three Acres Originally Granted unto Robert Ramsey and Signed by his Excellency William Moultrie on the fourth day of December one thousand Seven hundred and Eighty six as by a plat annexed to the said Grant will more fully appear Together with all and singular the houses out houses
