

22<sup>nd</sup> The following Title Bond from John Childress to Charles Bruce  
was produced in Open Court November Term 1790 proven before  
Robert Nelson Esq<sup>r</sup> by the Oath of John Thomas Sen<sup>r</sup> and Ordered to  
be Recorded. Recorded this 22<sup>nd</sup> November 1790.

South Carolina I know all men by these presents that I John Childress  
of Greenville County in the state aforesaid do herby am firmly bound and  
Obliged unto Charles Bruce of the County and State aforesaid Carpenter  
in the sum of one hundred Pounds Sterling Money to be paid unto the  
said Charles Bruce his certain Attorney his Heirs Executors & Administra-  
tors to which payment will and truly to be done I bind myself my Heirs  
Executors and Administrators firmly by these presents sealed with my  
seal and dated the first day of November 1790

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above  
bound John Childress do and shall upon and at the request of the  
said Charles Bruce his Heirs and assigns or on or before the first of Feb-  
ruary next ensuing the date above written convey and assure or cause  
to be will and sufficiently bonvoyed and assured unto the said Charles  
Bruce his Heirs and assigns or to such other person or persons and his  
and their Heirs as the said Charles Bruce shall nominate and appoint  
and to such uses as he shall direct one & telle usage or Tenement or  
Tract or parcel of Land situate on Childress Beaverdam or Branch of  
South Figar River including the place whereon the said Childress now  
lives and to be divided from the other land as follows Viz to begin on the  
Creek of said Beaverdam on Salmons line thence along said line to the  
wagon Road leading from Millford to Mr<sup>r</sup> Nichols and up the said  
Beaverdam as high up the said Creek & Road as that a line from the Creek  
to the Road running the same course of Salmons line aforesaid so as  
to make one hundred Acres by such Conveyance and assurances in the  
law, as by the said Charles Bruce his Heirs or assigns or his or their counsil  
learned in the law shall be Reasonably devised or advised and Required free  
and discharged of and from all Incumbrance whatsoever and also if the said  
John Childress his Heirs Exec<sup>r</sup> or Adm<sup>r</sup> and either of them do and shall  
until such conveyance & assurance be made & executed as aforesaid purin  
& suffer the said Charles Bruce his Heirs and assigns peaceably & quietly to  
to have Receive & take to his or their own use & uses the proportion Rent  
Fees and profits of all and singular the premises and of every part and  
parcel thereof without any manner of trouble disturbance hindrance  
or denial of the said John Childress his Heirs Exec<sup>r</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup> &c or any of them  
or of any other person or persons whatsoever or of any of their means  
procurement Right or Title or claim of or to the said above plantation  
or Tract of one hundred Acres of Land then this Obligation to be void
