

 courses profits commodities advantages heridatements & appurtenances whatsoever
 to the Tract of sixty nine acres of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining
 and the Reversion, Reversions, Remainder & Remainders, Rents Issues and pro-
 fits of the sd. premises & of every part & parcel thereof & all the estate Right Title
 Interest claim & demand whatsoever of him the said William Benson of in &
 to the sd. Tract of sixty nine acres of Land & premises & every part thereof
 to have & to hold the sd. Tract of sixty nine acres of Land and all & singular
 other the premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with
 appurtenances unto the sd. Abraham Bradley his heirs and assigns for ever
 & the sd. William Benson for himself and his heirs & assigns the sd. Tract of sixty

The following deed of Conveyance from Thomas Lewis to Charles Studlesley ²³²
 was proven before Ambrose Blackburn Esq^r and Recorded this 25th Dec^r 1790

This Indenture made the ninth day of March one thousand seven
 hundred and ninety & of the Independence of the united states of America
 the fourteenth between Thomas Lewis of the state of South Carolina and
 Greenville County of the one part and Charles Studlesley of the County and
 State aforesaid Blacksmith of the other part Witnesseth that the sd. Thomas
 Lewis for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds Sterling to him
 in hand paid by the said Charles Studlesley the Receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged by the sd. Thomas Lewis hath Granted bargained sold aliened
 and Confirmed & by these presents doth Grant bargain sell alien & Confirm
