This Indenture made this Twenty ninth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred & Ninety & in the Fourteenth year of American Independence between Reuben Stringer of Greenville County & State of South Carolina of the one part & Thomas M<sup>c</sup>Carrel of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Reuben Stringer for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas M<sup>c</sup>Carrel the Receipt whereof the s<sup>d</sup> Reuben Stringer doth hereby acknowledge he the s<sup>d</sup> Reuben Stringer Bargained Granted & sold aliened & confirmed & by these presents doth Grant Bargain sell alene & Confirm unto the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas M<sup>c</sup>Carrel his Heirs & assigns for ever all that plantation or Tract of land situate & lying on the Beaver dam Creek a branch of Saluda River containing Three hundred acres be the same more or less bounded all sides by vacant Land when Run Granted to Ralph Smith Esq<sup>r</sup> the fifteenth of October in the year one thousand seven hundred & eighty four Recorded in the Secretarys Office Book Z<sup>o</sup> Z<sup>o</sup> Z<sup>o</sup> Page 324 Preference being there may more fully appear with all woods under Woods & other commons of Pastures commodities advantages hereditaments ways waters & appurtenances whatsoever there belonging or in any ways appertaining & also the Reversion & Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents & Services of the s<sup>d</sup> premises & every part thereof & all the estate Right Interest Claims & demands whatsoever him the s<sup>d</sup> Reuben Stringer or of him to the s<sup>d</sup> Tenements & premises & every part thereof to have & to hold the s<sup>d</sup> plantation or Tract of Land & all & Singular the said premises above mentioned & every part & parcel thereof with the appurtenances to the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas M<sup>c</sup>Carrel his Heirs & assigns for ever & the s<sup>d</sup> Reuben Stringer himself & his Heirs the s<sup>d</sup> plantation or Tract of
