

The following deed of Conveyance from Mary Burns to Martin Colothren was produced in Open Court & acknowledged by the s<sup>r</sup> Mary Burns & Oram to be Recorded. Recorded this 22 day of December 1790

This Indenture made this nineteenth day of June & in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety in the fourteenth year of American Independence between Mary Burns of the one part & Martin Colothren planter of the other part both of the state of South Carolina & County of Greenville; whereas in and by a certain Grant bearing date the thir day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty five & in the tenth year of the Independence of the united states of America under the Great seal of the state signed by His Excellency William Moultrie Governor & commander in chief in & over the s<sup>t</sup> State for that purpose appointed did give & Grant unto Mary Burns a Tract of Land containing Three hundred & Twenty Five acres, Situate in the district of ninety six Greenville County Horse Creek a branch of Reddy River & hath such shape form & Marks as are Represented by a plat to the Original Grant annexed Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the s<sup>r</sup> Mary Burns for & in consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds Sterling Money paid by him the s<sup>r</sup> Martin Colothren the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that she the s<sup>r</sup> Mary Burns hath Granted Bargained & Sold Remised Released & Conveyed & by these presents doth Grant Bargain sell Remise Release Convey & Confirm unto the s<sup>r</sup> Martin Colothren his heirs & assigns a part of the above mentioned Land supposed to contain Two hundred acres be the same more or less it being the South part of the above mentioned Land begining on John Deaneys Corner running s<sup>o</sup> Fifty West forty five chain to a Stake thence s<sup>o</sup> 80 East 100 chain to a Light-wood Stake thence North ten degrees East fourteen Chain to a hycory thence to a white Oak corner thence to a branch called the poplar bottom branch thence running the various Courses of s<sup>t</sup> branch to the head taking in the head Spring of s<sup>t</sup> branch thence to the line very near the begining Corner supposing to include Two hundred acres of Land be the same more or less with all &
