The following deed of conveyance from Isaac Reed to Lewis Wells was produced in Open Court & acknowledged by the s<sup>r</sup> Isaac Reed and ordered to be recorded Recorded this 30th day of December A.D. 1790.

South Carolina This Indenture made this Thirty First day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety & in the Fifteenth year of American Independence between Isaac Reed of the s<sup>t</sup> State & County of Greenville of the one part & Lewis Wells of the other party planter of the County & State afores<sup>d</sup>. Witnesseth that the s<sup>r</sup> Isaac Reed for in consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds lawful Sterling Money to him in hand paid at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents by the s<sup>r</sup> Lewis Wells the Receipt whereof the s<sup>r</sup> Isaac Reed doth hereby acknowledge & thereof & of & from every part & parcel thereof doth acquit & discharge the s<sup>r</sup> Lewis Wells his heirs & assigns & for divers other Goods & consideration hereunto moving have granted bargained sold & aliened Enfeoffed & confirmed & by these presents do bargain sell Enfeoff & confirm unto the s<sup>r</sup> Lewis Wells his heirs & assigns for ever all that Tract of Land lying & being in Ninety six District Greenville County & on the head of Rocky Creek a branch of Reedy River containing Two hundred acres & first granted unto the s<sup>r</sup> Isaac Reed & signed by his Cellency Thomas Pinckney on the second day of July 1787 as by the s<sup>r</sup> Grant & plat annexed thereto will fully appear beginning a State marked thus 8+ running s. 45 & 50 ch Stationed on a Spanish Oak thence to a station on a black Oak & corners on a black Oak marked thus 8+ thence s 45 & 40 ch to a station on a Spanish Oak & then to a station on a post Oak & then to the corner on a stone 8+ thence s 45 & 50 chains Station on a black
