 sum of sixty pounds Sterling Money to him in hand paid at or before the sealing
 & delivering of these presents the Receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged & he the
 s^d. Jeremiah Webb Jun^r hath bargained sold Released & Confirmed & by these pre-
 sents doth Grant bargain & Release unto the s^d. David Black his heirs or assigns one certain
 piece of Land containing Two hundred & Fifty acres more or less situate lying on the
 Reedy Fork of Reedy River being a Tract of Land Granted to Originally to James Cad-
 well by His Excellency William Moultrie Esq^r dated August one thousand seven
 hundred & eighty six situate lying & being in ninety six District bounded to the
 East on land laid out for Robert Gilliam & by vacant land on all other sides at
 the time of surveying & hath such shape form & marks as the plat thereof Directs
 to the Original Grant annexed together with with all & singular the s^d Tract of
 Two hundred & Fifty Acres of Land unto the s^d. David Black his heirs & assigns for
 ever to have & to hold the s^d. piece of Land afores^d. with all the premises & every thing
