 hundred and ninety one between the Elcks of Ninety six District & Green-
 ville County of the one part, and Reuben Brown of said County of the other part

 thirty pounds lawful sterling Money to him in hand well and truly paid
 by the said Reuben Brown at & before the sealing and delivery of these pre-
 sents the Receipt thereof is hereby fully acknowledged have Granted bargain-
 ed sold aliened Released and confirmed and by these presents do Grant
 bargain alien Release and confirm unto the s^d Reuben Brown his heirs and
 assigns for ever all that part of a certain Tract of Land lying and being in the
 County of Greenville on Horse Creek waters of Reedy River Originally
 Granted unto the said the Elcks and signed by his Excellency William
 Moultrie on the 1st day of May 1786 for 440 Acres all that part of the s^d
