The following Deed of Conveyance from George Hays to William Taylor was proven before Isaac Morgan Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of John Hays produced in Open Court and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 17<sup>th</sup> of May 1791

This Indenture made this Twentieth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight and of the Independence of the united States of America the thirteenth between George Hays of the State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina & Greenville County of the one part and William Taylor of the State and County afores<sup>d</sup> of the Other Part witnesseth that the s<sup>r</sup> George Hays for and in consideration of the sum of Forty Pounds Sterling Money to him in hand well & Truly Paid by the s<sup>r</sup> William Taylor at & before the Sealing and delivering of these Presents the Receipt whereof the s<sup>r</sup> George Hays doth hereby acknowledge he the s<sup>r</sup> George Hays hath Granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed & by these Presents doth Grant bargain & sell alien and confirm unto the s<sup>r</sup> William Taylor his heirs and assigns for ever a certain Tract or Parcel of Land containing two hundred acres situate in Greenville County on Branch of Enoree River begining Red Oak Corner 30 & 50 chain thence to a post Oak 50 & 36 Chain to a Hickory 40 & 16 Chain thence to a Stake & 40 & 82 Chain it being a certy of a Tract containing Two hundred Acres Granted to the s<sup>r</sup> George Hays under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esq<sup>r</sup> bearing date the third day of April Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred & Eighty six
