

48 The following deed of Conveyance from Robert Harrison to Martin Webb was acknowledged before Robert McFee Esq^r and recorded this 29th Sept. 1791

This Indenture made this 26th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety one & of the Independance of the United States of America the fifteenth between Robert Harrison of the County of Greenville and state of S. Carolina of the one part & Martin Webb of the state and County aforesaid of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Robert Harrison for & in consideration of the sum of seventy five pounds Sterling to him in hand well & Truly paid by the said Martin Webb the Receipt whereof the said Robert Harrison doth hereby acknowledge he the said Robert Harrison hath granted bargained & sold aliened & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain & sell alien & confirm unto the s^d Martin Webb his heirs and assigns for ever a certain Tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred acres of land be the same more or less situate in the County & state aforesaid on Saluda River which said Tract of one hundred acres of land was granted unto Paul Fountain under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esquire Governor & commander in chief by Grant bearing date the fourth day of July one thousand seven hundred & eighty five it being half of the said Two hundred acres of Land granted unto the s^d Paul Fountain beginning on a Hogcory on the Bank of Saluda at the corner of the s^d Robert Harrison's Fence thence a conditional along the fence to a white Oak down the said fence to a Red Oak, thence to an old pine on the Edge thence along the said line to a Chesnut thence the surveyed line to a Hogcory thence along the said line
