This Indenture

made this fourth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred Ninety Two and in the sixteenth year of American Independance Between Hugh McVay Sheriff of the County of Greenville of the one part and Jesse Carter of the County & State aforesaid of the Other part Witness -  
-eth, - Whereas Daniel McMillin was lately Taken, seized, in fee simple to him and his heirs for ever, of and in all that plantation or Tract of land containing Two hundred & twenty five acres be the same more or less situate lying & being in the District of Washington, Greenville County, on the waters of Tygar River Beginning at a post St, thence S. E. 18 1/2<sup>o</sup> 50 l<sup>h</sup>. to a Red Oak St, thence S 80 E 51 1/2<sup>o</sup> to a Red Oak St, thence S 42 E 23 1/2<sup>o</sup> 5 l<sup>h</sup>. to a post Oak St thence S 36 E 42 1/2<sup>o</sup> to a Red Oak St thence N 20 W 110 1/2<sup>o</sup> 50 l to a stake St, thence S 78 W 31 1/2<sup>o</sup> to a white Oak St thence N 27 1/2<sup>o</sup> 50 l. to a Red Oak St thence N 21 1/2<sup>o</sup> 50 l to the beginning, Whereas the s.<sup>d</sup> Daniel McMillin in July Term in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Ninety one did Commence an Action of damage in the County Court aforesaid against Jesse Morton & Jeremiah Dutton in which Action the said Daniel McMillin came personally into Court and Ordered the said Action to be Dismissed upon which Request the Court Ordered Judgment Accordingly for the costs in that suit expended in
