done this 24th day of February 1792

This Indenture made the twenty third day
of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and ninety and in the fifteenth year of the
Independancy of America Between William Young
of Greenville County in the state of South Carolina
of the one part & John Young Jun^r of Spartanburg
County & State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth
that for and in consideration of the sum of one Spanish
Milled Dollar to the said William Young to him in
hand paid by the said John Young Jun^r the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the s^r William
Young hath granted Bargained & sold aliened & confirmed
conveyed & confirmed & by these presents do give Grant
Bargain sell, alien & confirm unto
the s^r John Young Jun^r his heirs & assigns all that
Tract & plantation of land, containing six hundred
Acres situate lying & being in the County of Greenville
aforesaid lying & being on both sides of Teedy Tover
Bounding to the south on lands surveyed for John
Young North & East on William Youngs land West &
S^r West on Maj^r Gowen's land it being a Tract
Granted by his Excellency Benquerard Esq^r to William
