hand paid by the s^r. Shields Booker at & before the sealing &
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
- knowledged, have granted Bargained sold aliened Released
and confirmed & by these presents do Grant bargain sell &
confirm unto him the s^r. Shields Booker his heirs and
assigns for ever one certain Tract of land being part of
Two Surveys lying and being in the County of Greenville
& State of S. Carolina containing three hundred & ten acres
be the same more or less two hundred & fifty on the Manor
