Samuel Steel to Adonias Burke was witnessed by
Robert Maxwell Esq^r. presented in Court February
Term 1792 and Ordered to be recorded, which was
done this 8th March 1792

S. Carolina. Know all men by these presents
Greenville County } that we John Steel & Samuel Steel
both of the state and county aforesaid planters are
held and firmly Bound unto Adonias Burke Esq^r.
of Charleston in the penal of sixty six pounds thirteen
shilling and four pence Sterling to the which payment will
and truly to be made and done, we do bind ourselves each
and every of our Heirs Esq^r. Adm^r. & assigns firmly severally
by these presents sealed with our seals & dated this 20th
day of January 1789

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if
the above Bound John Steel & Samuel Steel their Heirs
Esq^r. or Adm^r. shall and as well & truly pay or cause to be
paid unto Adonias Burke Esq^r. his certain Attorney Esq^r.
Adm^r. or assigns the full and just sum of thirty three pound
six shillings & eight pence Sterling with lawful Interest
from this date, payable in Charleston Warehouse Tobacco
notes (or other Merchantable produce at that place) at Cash
price on or before the Twenty fifth day of December Ensu-
ing which will in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven
