

140 The following Deed of Conveyance from Paul & Abner  
to Robert Seago was produced in open Court & May  
Term 1792 and acknowledged by the s<sup>r</sup> Paul Abner  
and ordered to be Recorded which was done this  
20<sup>th</sup> day of July 1792.

This indenture made the seventh day of April  
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred  
and ninety two and in the seventeenth year of American  
Independency between Paul Abner of the state of South  
Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part, and  
Robert Seago of the state and County afores<sup>d</sup> of the other  
part Witnesseth that the s<sup>r</sup> Paul Abner for and in  
consideration of the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling  
Money to him in hand paid by the s<sup>r</sup> Robert Seago  
at and before the sealing & delivering of these presents  
the receipt whereof the s<sup>r</sup> Paul Abner doth hereby  
acknowledge he the s<sup>r</sup> Paul Abner hath granted bar-  
gained and sold aliened & confirmed & by these presents  
doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the  
said Robert Seago his heirs and assigns for ever  
a certain tract or parcel of land containing ninety acres  
more or less, situate in Greenville County on Brush  
Creek of Enoree river begining on Paul Abner's North  
East Corner from thence to the road, so long road to  
Paul Abner's spring from thence down spring branch  
to Brush Creek from thence down s<sup>d</sup> creek to line  
from thence to the begining it being a part of land  
whereon Paul Abner now lives reference being thereunto  
may more fully appear Together with all trees woods  
under woods, Tithes commons common of pasture  
profits commodities hereditaments & appurtenances  
whatsoever to the said Messuage or Tenement &  
premises above mentioned belonging or in anywise
