This Indenture made the fifth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Ninety Three Between John Thomas Junr. of Greenville County & State of South Carolina of the one part & William Robbs of the County & State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Thomas for & in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Good & Lawfull money of the S<sup>t</sup>. State to him in hand well & Truly paid by the said William Robbs before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said John Thomas Junr. hath granted bargained, sold, aliened, released, conveyed & confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release, convey, & confirm unto the said William Robbs his heirs & assigns for ever, in his Actual profession now being a certain Tract plantation & Tract of land containing by Estimation Two hundred & forty nine Acres lying & being in Greenville County aforesaid on both sides of Hamiltons Branch of the South side of Tygar river bounding on said river on lands laid out to Josiah Culbertson & John Hampton the said Tract or parcel land being part of a Tract of four hundred & eighty seven acres the portion being of Robert hundred & eighty seven acres, and hath such shape & any thousands less hundred & eighty seven Marks as appears by a plat thereof to the said annexed which said plat & Grant being duly recorded in the Secretarys Office reference being thereunto had may may more fully appear which said Tract of land was conveyed unto the said John Thomas by the said Joseph Obanony an Indenture bearing date the eighteenth day of August one thousand seven hundred & eighty nine, said conveyance was duly recorded in the Clerks Office of the said County, as reference thereunto being had will also appear Together with all & singular the Houses, out houses Gardens orchards Trees woods commons commons of pasture profits & Commodities advantages
