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The following Deed of Conveyance from Vachel Dillingham
to Ovington Silps being proven before George Salmon Esquire
was presented in Court May Term 1793 and Ordered to be
Recorded which was done this 5th day of June 1793.
This Indenture made the Twenty third day of April
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
ninety three Between Vachel Dillingham of Greenville County
and State of South Carolina of the one part, and Ovington Silps
of the same place of the other part Witnesseth that the said
Vachel Dillingham for and in Consideration of the sum of
fifty pounds Sterling Money to him the said Vachel Dillingham
in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by this
