

262 The following Deed of Conveyance from Nicanor Hudson to William Nancy being proven before John Alexander Esquire was presented in Court May Term 1793 and ordered to be Recorded, which was done this 19th Day of June 1793

This Indenture made this Twelfth Day of January one thousand seven hundred and ninety three between Nicanor Hudson of South Carolina & Greenville County of the one part & William Nancy of the said State Pendleton County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Nicanor Hudson for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Pounds lawful sterling Money to him in hand well & Truly paid at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents by the said William Nancy the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged has given granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto him the said William Nancy him his heirs & Assigns for ever a certain Tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Greenville and on Rocky Creek and reedy river &c, all the land Vested in the said Nicanor Hudson by Virtue of a Deed of Conveyance made to the said Hudson by James Harrison bearing date on the tenth day of November one thousand seven hundred and ninety two reference therunto will more fully appear, also all the land Vested in the said Nicanor Hudson by Virtue of a Deed of Conveyance made by Lewis Dwell unto the said Nicanor Hudson bearing date on the ninth day of March one thousand seven hundred & Eighty Eight reference therunto may fully appear, also all the land vested in the said Hudson by Virtue of a grant made to the said Nicanor Hudson under and by the Authority of the State of South Carolina bearing date & signed by Governor Moultrie on the sixth day of November one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six reference therunto will fully appear containing by Estimation four hundred acres by the same more or less bounded westward the outward banks of reedy river Eastward by James Caspers land Northward by Ezekel Henderson & William Richardsons land North Westward by Lewis Dwell & Thomas Longs land
