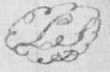

The following Deed of Conveyance from Archerbald Dill
 To James Copeland being proven before Reuben Barnett
 Esquire was presented in Court October Term 1799 and
 Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 11th June 1799
 This Indenture made thirtieth day of March in the
 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety
 three and in the sixteenth year of our Independence between
 Archerbald Dill of the County of Greenville and State of
 South Carolina planter of the one part and James Copeland
 of the County & State aforesaid planter of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Archerbald Dill for and in consid-
 eration of the sum of one hundred pounds lawful money to
 him in hand well and truly paid by the said James Copeland
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said Dill
 fully satisfied by the said Archerbald Dill hath granted
 bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain
 sell alien Enfeoff and confirm unto the said James Copeland
 all that messuage tract or parcel of land situate in the said
 County of Greenville on the waters of Parks Creek a branch of the
 South fork of Cigar river being part of a Tract of land granted
 to the said Archerbald Dill By a grant bearing date the twenty
 first day of January one thousand seven hundred and eighty
 five and in the ninth year of the Independence of the United States
 of America under the hand of his Excellency Benjamin Gurard
 and the seal of the said State being duly Recorded in the
 Secretarys Office of said State reference therunto had will
 more fully appear Beginning at an agreed corner tree between
 Major John Cowan and the said Copeland it being and oak
 running thence North sixty East forty four chains along the old
 line to an oak thence South thirty East fifty five chains to
 a post oak thence South sixty West forty five chains to an agreed
 145 Chestnut Tree between the above said Cowan and Copeland thence
