The following Deed of Conveyance from Obadiah Hooper Sen.  
to Richard Hooper being proven before Nathaniel Perry of  
Pendleton County by the oath of John Hooper was presented  
to the Office and Recorded this 19<sup>th</sup> of September 1793.  
This Indenture made this sixteenth day of February  
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and  
ninety two and in the sixteenth year of the sovereignty &  
Independence of the united states of America Between  
Obadiah Hooper Sen.<sup>r</sup> of Franklin County in the State of  
Georgia of the one part, and Richard Hooper of Greenville  
County in the State of South Carolina of the other part  
Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of  
Eighty pounds Sterling in hand paid to the said Obadiah  
Hooper by the said Richard Hooper before the signing and  
delivery hereof the said Obadiah Hooper hath lawfully bar-  
gained sold conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents  
doth bargain sell, convey and confirm unto the said Richard  
Hooper a certain plantation or Tract of land containing  
four hundred and Twenty two acres situate in Greenville  
County on Armstrong's Creek waters of Saluda River  
Granted to the said Obadiah Hooper, the first day of August  
one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five by his  
Excellency William Moultrie Esq. and hath such shape  
form marks battings and bounding as a plat to the  
Original grant annexed represents, also another certain  
Tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and Ninety  
four acres, situate in the aforesaid County of Greenville  
adjoining the aforesaid plantation, or Tract of land on
