336 The following deed of Conveyance from John Stewart to Rufel Cannon being proven before John B. Grigby Esquire by the oath of George Bailey & David Bailey was presented and Recorded this 20th day of September 1798

This Indenture made the thirteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety two, and in the fifteenth year of American Independence Between John Stewart of the State of South Carolina of the one part and Rufel Cannon of the State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth whereas in and by a certain grant bearing date the fifth day of February Done thousand seven hundred & Eighty seven and in the eleventh year of the Independence of the united States of America under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esq^r Governor and commander in chief in and over the said State for the time being the great seal of the state thereunto affixed being for that purpose did give and Grant unto Robert Bean a plantation or Tract of land containing one hundred & Twenty acres situate in the District of ninety six and on the North Side of Saluda River & und hath such shape form & Marks Bullings and bounding as appears by a plat to the said Grant annexed which said plat and Grant being duly
