


to James Nichol being acknowledged before John Thomas  
Jurat & John Thomas Jun<sup>r</sup> Esquire was Recorded this  
19<sup>th</sup> Day of October 1793

Know all men by these presents that I William Miller a  
Soldier in the South Carolina Independant companies  
Enlisted by Capt. Binf<sup>th</sup> Lutt whilst at Fort Rutledge in the  
Service of the united States and on the continental estab-  
lishment do hereby make constitute and appoint James  
Nichols of Quinceville County in the State of South Carolina  
my true & lawful Attorney to ask demand and Receive  
my pay or arrearages of pay due me as a soldier aforesaid  
from the united States or the State of South Carolina  
Ratifying & confirming all that my said Attorney shall  
do in the premises To give Receipt or Receipts for the same  
and to do all lawful acts and things necessary for ef-  
fecting the same as fully & effectually to all Intents &  
purposes as I might or could do if I were personally  
present at the Office or else where and done the same  
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed  
my seal on the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of October in the year of our Lord 1793
