

356 The following deed of Conveyance from John Clayton to John Stanford being proven before Reuben Barnett, Esq. by the oath of John Earley was presented and Recorded this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of November 1793.

This Indenture made the Eighth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three and in the sixteenth year of our American Independence between John Clayton of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina planter of the one part & John Stanford of the County & State aforesaid planter of the other part. Witness that the said John Clayton for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Lawful Money to him in hand well and truly paid by the said John Stanford the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said John Clayton fully satisfied he the said John Clayton have granted bargained & sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and Confirm unto the said John Stanford all that & Mortgage tract or parcel of Land situate in the said County of Greenville on Faulkenberry's Beavordam at a ranch of the middle fork of Tygar River being part of a tract of Land granted to the said John Clayton by Deed from William Swift granted to the said William Swift by a grant bearing date the sixth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty six under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie and the seal of the said State being duly Recorded in the Secretary's Office of said State Reference therunto had will more fully appear beginning at a pine near the Ridge Road Running thence to a Channel in the fork of the Ridge Road thence to a broken pine thence to a split Bush, thence to a Hickory, thence to a post oak thence to the Spring branch below the head of the Spring thence down the branch to a red oak thence to a black oak on the supposed line between Clayton & Swift thence along said line to the beginning tree containing by Estimation one
