

989 The following Deed of Conveyance from William Hooper to
William Goodlett being proven before Samuel Earle Esq. by
the oath of John Goodlett was Recorded this 17th Dec. 1793
This Indenture made the second of April in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three
and in the seventeenth year of the Independence of the
United States of America Between William Goodlett of
Greenville County of the one part & William Hooper of
Greenville County of the other part Witnesseth that that
the said William Hooper for and in consideration of the
sum of ninety pounds paid to him in hand paid by Willi-
am Goodlett at and before the sealing and delivery of these
presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath
granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed &
by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm
unto the said William Goodlett his heirs
and assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land laying
and being situate in the County of Greenville State of
South Carolina & District of Washington on the Waters of Saluda
by Estimation two hundred acres of land by the same more
or less beginning at the beginning corner on a Red oak thence
N.W. 43 to a post oak on Goodlett & McCoy's line that he had
of Gardner to a black post oak that divides Nicholas Fisher
and McCoy from thence on the conditional line to a stake
on Rudy River running up the River to a black oak from
thence to the beginning which being part of a certain tract
of land that the said Gardner held by a certain Grant
bearing date the first day of January one thousand seven
hundred and eighty seven and Recorded in Grant book 22
23 bearing date under the hand of William Moultrie Esq.
Governor and commander in Chief and great seal of the State
for that purpose and duly Recorded in the Secretarys Office
of the State reference thereunto had may now fully appear
which said Tract of two hundred acres of land as aforesaid with
