he at that price being the highest & last Bidder thereof according
to the usage & Customs of Virginia Now this Indenture Witness-
eth that the said Samuel Saxon for & in consideration of the
aforesaid sum of Twenty Eight pounds Sterl^o to him in hand
well & truly paid by the said John Wilson the Receipt whereof
he doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained & sold by this
presents both grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said John
Wilson his heirs Exors Adms^r or assigns for ever all the afores^d tract
or parcel of land containing one thousand acres together with
all singular the premises & appurtenances thereto belonging
or in any wise appertaining & all the estate right title Interest
property Claim or demand of the aforesaid John Goodwyn of
inc^o to the said tract of one thousand acres of land together
with all and singular the rights Timber & appurtenances
and the Reversion and Reversions, Remainder & Remainders
Rents Issues & profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof to
have and to hold the said plantation or tract of one thousand
acres of land & premises with the appurtenances thereto be-
longing unto the said John Wilson his heirs Exors Adms^r or assigns
for ever In Testimony whereof the said Samuel Saxon hath
197 percents set his hand & seal the day & year first herein written
