

515. The following Mortgage from John Birdsong to Hinson Kennedy being proven before Parkin Larrant Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Elias Williams was presented and recorded this 24<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1794

This Indenture made this first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Ninety four, & in the eighteenth year of the Independence of the United States Between John Birdsong Farmer of Greenville County & State of South Carolina of the one part, & Hinson Kennedy Merchant of the County & State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that whereas the said John Birdsong is and stands Justly Indebted unto the said Hinson Kennedy by two Bonds & one note which are as followeth Viz, the first Bond granted the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June for fifty three pounds 12/6 one thousand seven hundred and ninety three, the second Bond granted the 30<sup>th</sup> April 1794 for thirty four pounds and the note granted the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 1793 for fifteen pounds In consideration thereof and as well for the better securing, and more sure payments of the said Bonds & Note to the said Hinson Kennedy their Executors Administrators and assigns on or before the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December next ensuing the date hereof, as also for the better securing & more sure payment to them of all such debts as he the said John Birdsong shall hereafter Contract with the said Hinson Kennedy, at such days & times, and in such manner & form as the same shall grow due & owing from time to time according to the Tenor & Effect of every future contract and agreement to be made between said John Birdsong & Hinson Kennedy, and for divers other good causes and considerations the said John Birdsong therecto especially moving hath granted bargained & sold the following property, and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell alien and release unto the said Hinson Kennedy a tract of land containing three hundred acres for the consideration of the first Bond above mentioned amounting to fifty three pounds 12/6
