

520 The sum of three hundred pounds sterling to him in hand paid by the said Jesse Holland, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Shields Booker hath bargained and sold, and by these presents doth bargain sell to the said Jesse Holland his heirs & assigns for ever, a certain Tract or parcel of land containing three hundred acres be the same more or less situate in Greenville County on Saluda River, and bounded as follows, To wit, by the land of Thomas Jones, Joseph Hood, John Jones, & Mary Sowell's line to her Spring Branch, thence down her Spring Branch to the Mill Creek, thence down the said Creek to the Mill, then by the lands of Daniel McKinnon to the mouth of the said Mill Creek, thence down the river as it Meanders to Thomas Jones's Corner on the River which said Tract of Land of three hundred & Ten acres be the same more or less, with all and every of its appurtenances the said Shields Booker doth from himself and his heirs and from any other person or persons whatsoever warrant and will for ever defend to the said Jesse Holland his heirs and assigns for ever In Witness whereof the said Shields Booker hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the day and year first above written

53 The following Lease from Robert McClintock to William McClintock being proven before Wm Hunter Esq. by the oath of Andrew Park the same being accompanied with a Release was presented & recorded this 30<sup>th</sup> day of Oct. 1794 State of South Carolina This Indenture made the thirtieth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four and in the eighteenth year of the Independance of the united States of America between Robert McClintock of the County of Laurens State afores. of the one part and William McClintock of Greenville County said State of the other part, now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Robert McClintock for & in consideration
