John Rodgers being proven before William Mitcherson Esq^r by the
oath of Parkin Tarrant was Received this 6th day of April 1795
This Indenture made this Eleventh day of April in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety three & in the seven-
teenth year of American Independence between James M^r Williams
of the State of S^c Carolina & County of Pendleton of the one part, &
John Rodgers of the State aforesaid & County of Greenville of the
other part Witnesseth that the said James M^r Williams for & in consi-
deration of the sum of one hundred pounds to him in hand paid
by the said John Rodgers, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
he the said James M^r Williams hath granted bargained & sold
& by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said John
Rodgers his heirs & assigns for ever sixty acres of land being part of a
tract containing two hundred & thirty five acres (the said Grant bearing
date the 6th day of October 1788 from under the hand of his Excellency
