 This Indenture made this Twenty fourth day of January One thousand seven hundred and ninety three & of the Independence of the United States the eighteenth Between Unity Moore of the state of South Carolina & County of Greenville of the one part, & John McCormick of the ~~state~~ ^{state} & County afores. of the other part Witnesseth for & in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling lawful Money of S. State in hand paid by John McCormick hath bargained and sold & by these presents doth bargain sell & make over unto said John McCormick a certain plantation or tract of land lying in Greenville County on Rocky Creek of Enoree River which John McCormick now lives on & hath such boundaries whereas it begining on a stake on certain line on Len. Hudsons land thence running N to the corner post oak thence S 6 to stake corner near some saplin thence N to post oak saplin, thence N to red oak corner, thence to stake on certain line on Len. Hudsons land thence along certain to the begining it bring apart of a tract of land containing two hundred & fourteen acres granted unto Francis Tuleher from under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esq. bearing date the fourth day of Dec. one thousand seven hundred & eighty six Recorded in Book L L L L page 231 he hath granted bargained & sold & by these presents doth bargain sell & convey unto the said John McCormick a tract of land containing one hundred & seven acres more or less together with the woods waters hereditaments and appurtenances unto the said land belonging or in any wise appertaining and reversion & reversions Remainder & remainders rents Issues & profits thereof to have & to hold the granted premises of the above mentioned tract of land unto the said John McCormick his heirs ^{adm.} or assigns for ever & y^e.
