

The following Deed of Conveyance from John Turnbough to William Tubb being proven before Robert Mace Esq. by the oath of Jeremiah Tubb was presented and Recorded this 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1795

State of South Carolina This Indenture made this third day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety four & in the seventeenth year of the Sovereignty & Independency of the United States of America between John Turnbough of the aforesaid State & County of Greenville planter of the one part & William Tubb Snr. of the aforesaid State & County of Greenville planter of the other part Witnesseth that the S. John Turnbough for & in consideration of the full & just sum of forty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said William Tubb the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained & sold & by these presents doth give grant bargain sell & deliver unto the said William Tubb Snr. his heirs or assigns for ever in fee simple all that messuage & Tenament of land situate & lying in the County of Greenville & State aforesaid on Enoree River bounded by vacant lands containing three hundred and twenty three acres more or less it being a tract of land Granted unto said John Turnbough dated the fifth day of June one thousand seven hundred & eighty six as appears by Record in Secretarys Office in Grant Book N. N. N. page 110 having reference thereto being always had to have and to hold the above granted land with their appurtenances & hereditaments hereunto belonging unto him the said William Tubb Snr. his heirs and assigns for ever free & clear of all Incumbrances & from & against the claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever & the S. John Turnbough doth for himself his heirs and assigns all or either of them do warrant & for ever defend the above granted & bargained premises with its appurtenances unto him the S. William Tubb Snr. his heirs & assigns for ever In witness hereof I the S. John Turnbough have hereunto set my hand & Seal the day & year above written
