The following deed of Conveyance from Robert Gilliland to Samuel Johnson being proven before Robert Maxwell Esq. by the oath of Maj. John Hinson was presented & recorded 1st June 1796
This Indenture made the 16th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between Robert Gilliland of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part & Samuel Johnson of the said State & County of the other part witnesseth that said Robert Gilliland hath & does this day bargain sell and deliver alien release and confirm unto the said Samuel Johnson his heirs and assigns for ever a certain plantation or tract of land containing two hundred acres more or less lying in said County in full consideration for which the said Robert Gilliland doth hereby acknowledge to have received the sum of two hundred pounds sterling Money of said State which land of two hundred acres as aforesaid is bounded as follows beginning on a Maple corner on the north side of Saluda River thence running up Francis Kerbys Spring Branch to a Spanish oak, thence to Cravelleys corner on a red oak thence with Cravelleys line to a pine corner on Doagues Land and along said line to a stake corner, thence crossing a branch on said line to a stake corner, thence to a black oak corner on Doagues line, thence along said Johnsons line to a B oak corner on said river, thence with said river to the beginning Originally surveyed for John McElroy (being part of his tract of nine hundred & fifty acres) on the six day of January 1786 and Granted to James Nicholson on the fourth day of September 1786 and conveyed by said Nicholson unto said Gilliland by lease and release bearing date the second and third days of December one thousand seven hundred and ninety one recorded in the Clerks office of said County on the Twenty seventh day of December one thousand seven hundred and ninety two in Book 6 page 180 to 183 to have and to hold the aforesaid Granted premises to himself his heirs & assigns for ever together with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto in any wise belonging or appertaining hereby warranting and defending said premises or any part or parcel thereof to said Johnson his heirs and assigns for ever against the claim or title of any other person or persons whatsoever either in Law or Equity In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the day first above written
